

## Mini Charm Table Runner

A free pattern by Spinning Moon Designs

## Fabric

1 - mini-charms pack or 40-2 $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares
$1 / 2$ yard of contrast for sashing, border and binding

## Cutting

Sashing
Cut 3 strips $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ by WOF
Sub-cut these strips into $12-41 / 21$ segments
The remaining strips will be measured when the quilt is sewn.
Borders
2-2 $1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips
Binding
2-2 $1 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips

## Sewing

Separate the charm pack into colors and neutrals. Pair the color squares with neutral squares. Prints do not need to match. In fact, I tried not to match the prints.

Sew the color and neutral squares into pairs. Press toward darker color. Make 20 pairs.

Sew the pairs into 4 patch blocks, matching the colors in the blocks. Make 10.


Arrange the 4 patch blocks in way that is pleasing to you, 5 blocks across. Alternate the way the color squares as shown. Add the sashing between the blocks as shown, pressing toward the sashinng. Make 2 rows.


Measure your rows and cut your middle sashing to your measurement.

Cut the top and bottom borders to $21 \frac{1}{2}{ }^{\prime \prime}$. Sew 2 different color squares the ends of the border strips. Make 2. Sew to the top and bottom of quilt.


Cut 2-5 $1 / 2$ " border strips. Sew 1 square that matches the color square you sewed on the corresponding end of the border strip in the previous step. Then sew a contrasting color square for the corners. Quilt, bind and enjoy!
